### Building & Grounds

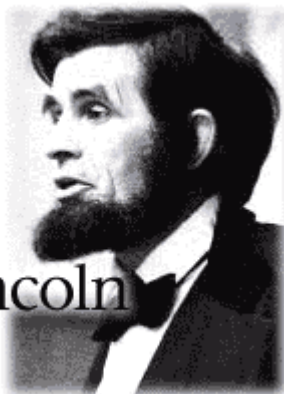
